

TALL LARKSPUR:



- Among all of the poisonous plants Tall Larkspur causes the greatest number of cattle deaths in Alberta.
- Grows to 2 m tall; blooms June-July.
- Leaves numerous, palmately 5-7 lobed; each lobe 2-3 times sharply divided or toothed. Leaves bluish green; slightly hairy.
- Flowers in long loose clusters at stem tips. Flowers large with deep blue to purple petals.
- Produce seed pods.
- Usually several stems; hollow, ridged, hairless, bluish green.
- Short, thick, tough root.
