

WATER HEMLOCK:



- **Extremely poisonous.**
 - Do not cut or break stems or roots.
 - Hollow, jointed stems grow 1 to 2 meters tall, blooms June-July.
 - Leaves are deeply veined and notched along the leaf margins.
 - Flowers numerous, small, white to greenish in several flat-topped, umbrella-like clusters.
