### Mayoral voting re-count in Parkland County

Following the October 15<sup>th</sup> municipal election process, Parkland County is conducting a vote re-count at the request of one of the mayoral candidates. The re-count will be conducted by the Returning Officer at Parkland County Centre on October 17<sup>th</sup> starting at 1:00 p.m.

Three candidates vied for the position of Parkland County Mayor in the 2007 election with unofficial results 48.5% or 2517 votes for Rob Weideman, 47.5% or 2464 votes for Phyllis Kobasiuk and 4% or 205 votes for Jim Rustand.

Voter turn-out within the County was 24.05%, with a total of 5,226 residents casting ballots at one of 23 civic polling stations throughout the municipality.

Official results will be released on October 19<sup>th</sup> and a Swearing-in ceremony will be held on October 22<sup>nd</sup> at the County Centre in Parkland County.
