Parkland County Announces Interim CAO

Parkland County Council has appointed current Assistant General Manager of Corporate Services, Al McCully, as interim Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) until a new CAO is hired. The position became vacant after Council accepted the retirement request of Commissioner Jim Simpson at a special Council meeting on February 20th. Mr. Simpson's retirement starts March 15th, and Mr. McCully will assume the interim CAO job March 16th.

Mr. McCully brings 25 years experience in municipal land use planning and development, both in the public and private sectors, to the position. He has worked with Alberta Municipal Affairs, Alberta Economic Development, and with City of Fort Saskatchewan before coming to Parkland County.

"My objective is to provide the organization with continued good management and leadership," said McCully. "And to ensure that Council continues to receive the best possible advice for the benefit of Parkland County residents and businesses."

Council will invite proposals from executive search firms to obtain candidates for Council's consideration as a new CAO.

"We want to ensure we find the right person to lead Parkland County," said Mayor Phyllis Kobasiuk. "These firms are designed to do assist us in identifying and locating that person."
