Parkland County has a Seasonal Equipment Operator III position available in the Engineering Services Department. You will report to the Construction Foreman and work as a team member of the Roadway Construction Crew primarily operating either a D5G Cat or a D7R Cat, in road construction duties including excavation, grade construction, base course construction, finishing work, etc. You will also be required to work on projects as a lead hand and perform a wide variety of labour related duties. Strong interpersonal and communication skills are required to deal with the general public and the private contracting industry.
