

AAMD&C SCHOLARSHIP

The Alberta Association of Municipal Districts & Counties (AAMD&C), an organization representing Alberta's incorporated rural municipalities, offers a Scholarship Program in support of rural students attending an Alberta university or college.

Under the AAMD&C Scholarship Program, five rural students each year will be provided with a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. To be eligible for this competition, an applicant must be a resident of an Alberta municipal district or county or the Special Areas, and must be enrolling in their first year of studies at a recognized Alberta post secondary institution. Further, the applicant must demonstrate that their course of studies is related in some way to local government and/or rural community interests. The application deadline for the AAMD&C Scholarship Program is July 31, 2007.
