### MORATORIUM ON LAND USE BYLAW AMENDMENTS FOR RE-DISTRICTING FROM AGG TO CRC

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#### COUNCIL TO REVIEW DEFINITION OF GOOD AGRICULTURAL LAND

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On June 24 Council made a motion that, as of JULY 11, 2008, Parkland County will no longer accept applications to amend the Parkland County Land Use Bylaw No. 15-00 to re-district land from the Agricultural General (AGG) District to the Country Residential Core (CRC) District until further notice. Council will remove this moratorium when it has completed its review of the definition of good agricultural land in the Municipal Development Plan. At the present time, the criteria used to define good agricultural land to support the conversion of agricultural land to multi-parcel residential subdivision is outlined in Policy 2.10 of the Parkland County Municipal Development Plan requiring a weighted farmland assessment rating criteria of 57%, or less, to support re-districting.

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
