

Parkland County Solid Waste Services Blue Bag Program



Parkland County is now accepting Blue Bag recyclable materials at the following locations:

**Kapasiwin Transfer Station
Entwistle Recycle Centre
Tomahawk Recycle Centre**

Parkland County Transfer Station & Recycle Centre will add Blue Bag Recycling in Fall/Winter 2009.



ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

All Acceptable Recyclable Materials are to be placed in Blue Recycling Bags (available at your local grocery store) or deposited loose into the designated bins. Recyclables in bags other than blue bags will be treated as garbage.

Please place the following materials into the bin marked "Mixed Container Recycling"

- **ALL NUMBERED PLASTICS** including detergent bottles, pop bottles, yoghurt containers. Note: Only plastic containers with a Plastics Identification Number are acceptable. The number can usually be found on the bottom of plastic containers inside of a Recycling Symbol.



- Milk jugs & milk cartons
- Tin cans
- Clear glass food jars (no coloured glass)

Please place the following materials into the bin marked "Mixed Paper Recycling"

- Corrugated cardboard
- Box board incl. cereal boxes, pasta boxes, etc.
- Newspaper, includes all newspapers and flyers
- Mixed Paper including brown paper bags, wrapping paper, office paper, envelopes, shredded paper, magazines

Please flatten all cardboard and box board and ensure all containers are rinsed and clean.

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- Styrofoam
- Lids of any kind
- Ceramics
- Diapers
- Soiled/Dirty Paper
- Coloured Glass
- Plastic bags
- Miscellaneous plastic without Identification Number
- Bubble Wrap, Ziplock Bags, Saran Wrap etc
- Toxic items, sharps (i.e. Needles, Broken Glass)
- Electronics
