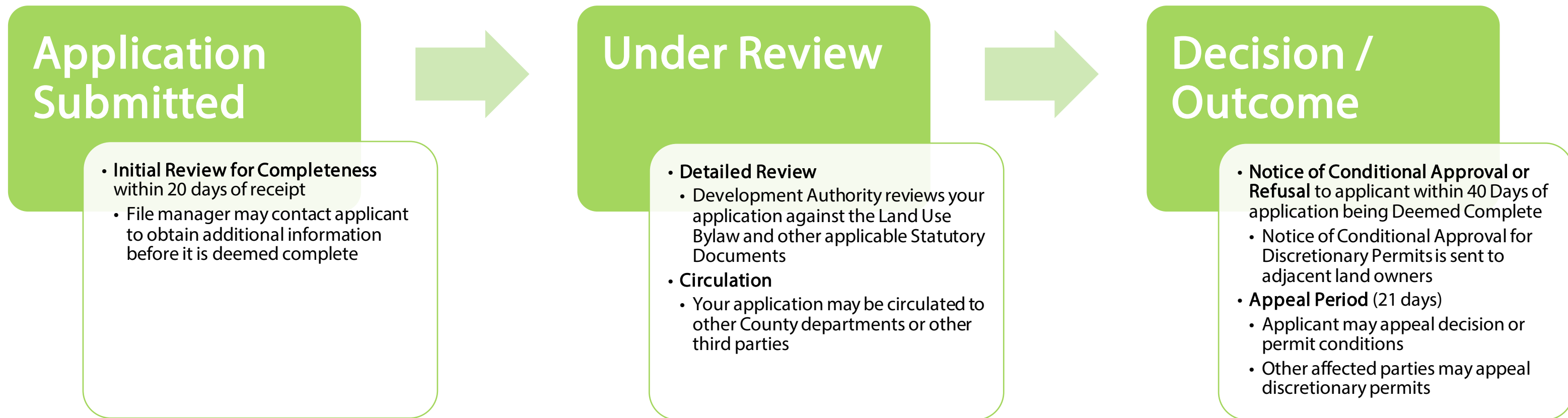


Development Permit Process

- A Development may be considered Permitted or Discretionary. Discretionary development permits will take additional processing time as they generally require additional circulations as well as an advertising and appeal period
- Development permit timelines vary based on the proposal's complexity, the degree of impact on the surrounding community, and when information is submitted to your file manager
