

Parkland County Council Meeting Recap for February 28, 2023

Celebrating Success

Council acknowledged Jack Lewis' Alberta Agriculture Hall of Fame Induction.

Notice of Motion - Council Information on Website

Council Member Birnie presented a Notice of Motion that at a regular meeting of Council on March 14, 2023, Councillor Birnie will move that all Requests for Decisions approved at Council meetings will be included on the County website in a separate tab under the category 'Mayor and Council'. The information will indicate the date that Council approved the action, the stage of the initiative, the anticipated completion date, and whether the initiative is on budget. Further, any Council direction provided to administration at a Council meeting should also be included on the website and tracked in a similar manner.

Notice of Motion - Myshak Road Dedication - Information Sign

Council Member Birnie presented a Notice of Motion that at a regular meeting of Council on March 14, 2023, Councillor Birnie will move that Council direct administration to bring information back to Council regarding the cost of a larger sign explaining the road dedication to Mike Myshak Sr. to be located in the pullout along Acheson Road at the March 28, 2023 Council meeting.

Notice of Motion - Council Public Contact Policy

Council Member Birnie presented a Notice of Motion that at a regular meeting of Council on March 14, 2023, Councillor Birnie will move that Council discuss a new policy regarding any meeting requests by residents to be directed to the Division Councillor as a primary contact.

Funding Request - Stony Plain and Parkland Pioneer Museum

Council received the Stony Plain and Parkland Pioneer Museum funding request presentation for information, and directed administration to include the request for \$75,000 for the Stony Plain and Parkland Pioneer Museum as part of the 2024 capital cost share budget request.

2022 Draft Corporate and Year End Update, Carry Forward Approval, Restricted Surplus Transfers, and Allowance Transfers

Council voted to approve the following:

1. That the Q4 Corporate and Year End Update be received for information.
2. That the Draft December 31, 2022, Financial Statements be received for information.
3. That Council direct administration to transfer \$ 2,581,000 to restricted surplus for incomplete programs and projects.
4. That the transfer of \$ 3,293,744 to restricted surplus and decrease to the Allowance for Uncollectible Accounts of \$ 8,800 be approved.



5. That administration be directed to transfer the remaining 2022 surplus to the Lifecycle Plans Restricted Surplus.
6. That Council approve the reallocation of restricted surplus funds.

Council gave Bylaw 2023-01 first and second reading.

Council approved additional funding of up to \$400,000 for the Wabamun Boat Launch to be funded from County Facilities Restricted Surplus.
