



Parkland County Council Meeting Recap for January 10, 2023

Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal

Brian Cornforth, Fire Chief for Parkland County was presented with the Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal. Council congratulated Chief Cornforth and thanked him for his service.

Proposed Wabamun Business Incubator

Council directed administration to research information related to the use of the Hamlet of Wabamun's administration building as a business incubator, or other use, with the intention of drawing new business into the Hamlet of Wabamun and Parkland County.

Motorized and Unmotorized Recreation Park

Council defeated a motion directing administration to explore the feasibility of starting a motorized and unmotorized recreation park on TransAlta lands.

Greater Parkland Regional Chamber of Commerce

Council received the Greater Parkland Regional Chamber of Commerce presentation for information.
