

Parkland County Council Meeting Recap – July 12, 2022

Agricultural Service Board - Proposed Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) Resolution

Council directed that a resolution be submitted to the July 25, 2022 RMA Pembina River Zone meeting for exemption on natural gas and propane for agriculture under the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act.

Council appointed Deputy Mayor Kucher-Johnson to represent Parkland County as the Resolution Champion for the July 25, 2022 Pembina River Zone Meeting.

Bylaw 2022-13 - Springbank Park Estates Redistricting (Land Use Bylaw 2017-18)

Council gave Bylaw 2022-13 first reading and scheduled a Public Hearing for September 13, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. in Council Chambers to hear public comment on Bylaw 2022-13.
