Notice of Motion - School Resource Officer

A notice of motion was made that at a regular meeting of Council on April 26, 2022, Mayor Gamble will move that Council direct Administration to present information in support of reinstatement of Parkland County's funding toward the Parkland School Division School Resource Officer at the May 24, 2022 Council meeting.

Hamlet of Wabamun Farmers' Market

Council received the Hamlet of Wabamun Farmers Market verbal update for information.

Cancellation of May 10, 2022 Council Meeting

Council cancelled the May 10, 2022 Council meeting.

Proposed Waterfront Parking Fee Changes for Wabamun Residents

Council approved that all Parkland County residents, which now includes the Hamlet of Wabamun, be required to pay for parking at the Waterfront Park Parking lot in the Hamlet of Wabamun.

2022 Final Operating and Capital Budget Adjustments

Council approved the following Final Operating and Capital Budget adjustments:

- 2022 Final Operating Program Budget which will increase the municipal tax levy by \$2,095,000.
- 2022 Final Operating Project Budget which has no impact on the municipal tax levy.
- 2022 Final Capital Budget which has no impact on the municipal tax levy.

Emerging Capital Projects

- Council directed Administration to proceed with planning for the Emerging Capital Projects and to bring back refined project estimates and a funding plan to Council.
- Council directed Administration to submit Prairies Canada Grant applications for investment in Acheson Business Park, Wabamun initiative projects, and/or Broadband Infrastructure Project.
- Council approved funding of up to \$590,000 from the Long Term Sustainability Restricted Surplus for the Wabamun Initiative projects design work.
- Council approved funding of up to \$200,000 from the Long Term Sustainability Restricted Surplus for the Broadband project design work.
- Council directed Administration to add the Strategic Municipal Development Plan update to the 2023 Budget.
