**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to provide recognition to Parkland County fire districts.

**POLICY STATEMENT**

Parkland County wishes to acknowledge and provide recognition to fire districts celebrating their 10<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup> or 60<sup>th</sup> year of providing fire services to residents and property within Parkland County.

**STANDARDS**

1. Parkland County will contribute \$2,000.00 to each Parkland County fire district hosting a function celebrating 10, 25, 40, 50 or 60 years of providing fire protection with County-owned equipment, as indicated below:

2. A suitably engraved plaque will be presented by Parkland County for 25 and 50 years, in recognition of Council's appreciation.

**SCOPE**

The policy applies to all fire districts in Parkland County that are either under the administration of Parkland County (i.e., Parkland Village, Tomahawk and Acheson), or those that have entered into an agreement with Parkland County to provide fire services (i.e., Devon, Stony Plain, Wabamun, Seba Beach, and Yellowhead).

**MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Fire Chief is responsible to ensure fire districts receive the appropriate recognition each year, and continue to monitor and evaluate this policy.
