Hello:

I just finished reading the agenda for the stop work order appeal hearing on Aug 29th. In part of the agenda there is an attachment from the Engineering Services Department stating the approach onto said land parcel a permit was granted under certain conditions. One of the conditions was that the approach off Lakeside Drive be removed with the area restored. This has not been done. The property owners have only dumped some felled trees across this access. It has not been restored to it's original condition.

Also, I encourage the engineering dept to inspect the culvert that was placed under the approach off RR55 onto said property as the north end is completely covered in with runoff of sand, dirt, and silt from the owners approach/driveway. There is no drainage happening under the approach whatsoever.

I understand that part of the condition of the permit being granted was that the culvert was to be kept clear so water runoff from north to south could occur. This is not the case at present.

I fully encourage the engineering dept to reinspect this work.
