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Respondent Questions and Answers

- 1. Under “Equipment Requirements” on Page 15 of the RFQ document, Parkland County is requesting five (5) 50 yard containers for recyclable materials. “Schedule I – Rate Bid Form” to the RFQ, however, states “40 or 50 yard” bins. Can you please clarify what size the County prefers?**

The 50 yard bins are preferred by the County, however 40 yard bins will be considered. Respondents are to indicate whether they are proposing 40 or 50 yard bins for this requirement in their submission.

- 2. In order to determine vehicle requirements, please confirm the weight range for full bins.**

Please refer to Section 2. *Equipment Requirements* on Page 15 of the RFQ.

- 3. Does the *Rate for Bin Switch-Out Unit Price (As Required)* column on the “Schedule I – Rate Bid Form” mean that the successful respondent is to immediately replace a container at the time a full container is picked up?**

The successful respondent will be required to “switch out” (replace) each full bin with an empty bin as required. In the event that a full bin cannot be hauled immediately, the successful respondent would be expected move the full bin to the designated storage area for future hauling and disposal.

4. Does the County have a preferred disposal location for branches and other organic material?

Parkland County does not have a preferred organics disposal location. Respondents are to identify their intended disposal location in their submission.

5. Is it necessary to provide a quotation for the two (2) optional contract extension terms?

Respondents are not obligated to provide a price for optional contract extension years, but they are encouraged to do so.

6. Is disposal or rebate pricing to be fixed for the contract term, or can it be varied based on current landfill rates and processing fees?

Fixed pricing is preferred by the County.

7. Can respondents quote rates for hauling only, and use the County's accounts at disposal facilities for the disposal / processing fee?

No. Respondents are to charge the County for tipping fees (based on weights) using the respondent's disposal location accounts.
