The following is to be included in Section 4.1.3 - Scope of Work:

“The design must meet the requirements of AEP’s Code of Practice for Wetland Replacement and that the project will be part of AEP’s Wetland Replacement Program.”

Proponent Questions and Answers

3. Is the County looking for Engineer/Consultants or Design Build Contractors?

Proponents are to provide proposal for the whole project including costs for design and construction. The proponent may function as the prime consultant to oversee the contractor doing the work if contractor services can not be performed in-house, however pricing for both aspects of the scope must be included in the proposal.

4. Will Parkland County accept AVETTA Certification in place of Certificate of Recognition (COR) requirements?

No, Parkland County will not accept AVETTA Certification in place of COR. The successful proponent must provide a valid COR or SECOR certificate from their organization or from their sub-Contractor who will be performing the Work.

Additional Information on the COR requirements are as follows:

Contracts will be awarded to proponents who, prior to the Submission Deadline, possess a Certificate of Recognition (“COR”) which is relevant to their industry and which is recognized by Alberta Human Resources and Employment, Workplace Health and Safety. This certificate may be from a sub-contractor who will be performing the Work for the successful proponent.

Respondents are advised that a small employer’s certificate of recognition (for employers with less than ten employees) is considered acceptable.

For respondents who have not obtained a Certificate of Recognition, a valid Temporary Letter of Certification (“TLC”) issued by the Alberta Construction Safety Association (“ACSA”) will be considered. Parkland County will confirm that the respondent possesses a COR, SECOR or a valid TLC through the Alberta Construction Safety Association.

It is the respondent’s responsibility to ensure his registration in the program is properly documented with the Alberta Construction Safety Association and the County will assume no liability for errors or omissions by the Alberta Construction Safety Association in this regard.
