The Alberta Building Code no longer addresses Asbestos Abatement requirements. Asbestos abatement requirements are now located in the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Code administered by Workplace Health and Safety of Alberta Employment and Immigration (AE&I).

2.2.13.1. Notification Before Starting

The Owner or Contractor proposing to alter or demolish a *building* shall notify in writing the *authority having jurisdiction* that the plans and specifications describing the asbestos management and abatement work have been submitted to Workplace Health and Safety for compliance with Occupational Health and Safety legislation and that the work has been completed.
