Tansy, Common Tanacetum vulgare Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

- •Information: Introduced as an ornamental, leaves have a strong odour when crushed.
- · Life cycle: Perennial.
- **Root:** Rhizomatous, woody.
- Leaves: Leaves alternate, consistent in size, and deeply divided into leaflets with toothed margins.
- Stems: 30cm -1.8m tall, often purplish red
- Flower: Numerous (20 to 100) yellow- orange, button-like flower heads appear in flat-topped, dense clusters on the terminal stem. Flowers lack long (ray) petals.
- Seed/Fruit: Yellowish brown seeds have five-toothed ridges.
- Toxic: Horses, cattle, humans.
- · Control: Chemical.
