



Prime Coat Application Notice

To: The Residents of Helenslea Heath

Planned Start Date: August 2, 2022

Central Civil Solutions Inc. will be starting asphalt paving on your street that will consist of the following construction work:

- Roadway Cleaning and Application of Asphalt Prime Coat. Asphalt Prime Coat is a wet tar that is applied to the gravel before paving.
- First Lift Asphalt Paving: The installation of the first lift of asphalt paving.

Throughout the duration of asphalt paving in your neighbourhood, **please be aware and inform your family of the following hazards** that will be protected with barricades:

- Areas will be barricaded off to let the Prime Coat cure. These areas will be restricted to vehicles and pedestrians. Please plan accordingly.
- If you need to leave your house by vehicle, please drive very slow even if the Prime Coat seems dry. If you are walking, stay on the grass or on areas where Prime Coat has not been applied.
- If the Prime Coat is driven or walked through, it can be tracked onto driveways, vehicles, clothing, shoes, ect. If you have driven through the Prime Coat, we recommend you do not park on concrete.
- Please refrain from walking pets through the Prime Coat.
- On garbage days, leave your bins at the end of your driveways. We will move the bins so the garbage truck can access them. The bins will be placed back onto your driveway. We recommend marking your bin with your house number.
- The drying time for Prime Coat is approximately 6 hours. Once dried, the area will be accessible to traffic.
- Not following the above directions can result in damage.
- Central Civil Solutions will not be liable for Prime Coat tracking onto your driveway, vehicle, ect.

Emergency access will always be maintained.

Weather Permitting Construction Activities will take place from 7:00am to 9:00pm, Monday through Saturday and the possible Sunday if required. We at Central Civil Solutions Inc. regard safety as a priority and would appreciate your assistance in adhering to and preserving the Construction Signs and barricades as they were placed. We will endeavour to limit the delays during this construction and apologize for any inconvenience. We thank you in advance for your patience.
