

PARKLAND COUNTY

BY-LAW No. 23-2004

BEING A BY-LAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSED PROPERTY WITHIN PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE 2004 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, Parkland County has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the Council meeting held in December 2003.

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for Parkland County for 2004 total \$32,257,477; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$14,633,536; and

WHEREAS, \$17,623,941 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs of the Tri Municipal Family Leisure Centre are \$449,594; and

WHEREAS, monies required by Ambulance Authorities are:

WHEREAS, the Council of Parkland County is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions; and

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in Parkland County as shown on the assessment roll is:

WHEREAS, the Province of Alberta's Order in Council #477/2000 dissolved the Village of Entwistle into Parkland County and the assessed value of all property in the former Village of Entwistle is \$13,948,630.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of Parkland County, in the province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of Parkland County:


