Objective Housing Insecurity



93%

Out of **93** survey submissions, **6** respondents were found to be housing secure, and **87** were found to be housing insecure.

An additional **185** individuals (dependents and adults) shared housing conditions with housing insecure respondents.

Reasons for Insecurity

- Don't make enough money
- Can't afford rent/mortgage
- Mental health issues

- No shelters in area
- Health concerns

Employment Status and Type



Only **32%** of housing insecure respondents are employed.

62% are full-time, **31%** are part-time, and **4%** working casual.
