

BYLAW 07-2008

A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO
AUTHORIZE PARKLAND COUNTY TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO BECOME
A MEMBER OF THE WEST INTER-LAKE DISTRICT (WILD) WATER COMMISSION

WHEREAS Parkland County wishes to become a member of the West Inter-Lake District Water Commission pursuant to part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A 2004, c. M-26 as amended);

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of Parkland County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1

SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "WILD Water Commission Authorization Bylaw" of Parkland County.

SECTION 2

WILD WATER COMMISSION

- 2.1 The Council of Parkland County is hereby authorized to make any necessary Agreements and take the necessary action together with the Council of any other Municipality or Municipalities for the purpose of becoming a member of the West Inter-Lake District (WILD) Water Commission as per Part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
