

BYLAW NO. 15-2009

BEING A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY TO AUTHORIZE THE WIND UP
AND DISSOLUTION OF THE PARKLAND AMBULANCE AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS pursuant to the terms contained in an Agreement dated the 17th day of May, 1983 between the City of Spruce Grove, the Town of Stony Plain, Parkland County, the Summer Village of Alberta Beach, the Village of Onoway and the Village of Wabamun (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), the parties to the Agreement provided for the establishment of the Parkland Ambulance Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority"); and

WHEREAS by an Agreement dated the 1st day of January, 1999 between the parties to the Agreement and the Town of Devon (hereinafter referred to as "the 1999 Agreement"), the parties to the Agreement provided for the addition of the Town of Devon as a member of the Authority and the Town of Devon became a party to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS the City of Spruce Grove ceased to be a member of the Authority on December 31, 2003; and

WHEREAS by Agreement dated the 1st day of January 2004, the members of the Authority entered into a second Amending Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Amending Agreement") to further amend the Agreement as amended by the 1999 Agreement to include the provision of Ambulance Services outside the Service Area as defined in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS the Minister of Health and Wellness has announced that the responsibility for governance and funding for ground ambulance and emergency services operations will be transferred to Alberta Health Services on April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS as a result of such announcement, the Board of Directors of the Authority has recommended to the members of the Authority that the Authority cease providing ambulance services on March 31, 2009, and that the governance, assets, liabilities and obligations of the Authority be transferred to Alberta Health Services effective April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS the members of the Authority, in contemplation of Alberta Health Services on April 1, 2009, becoming responsible for the provision of Ambulance Services in the Service Area, have each passed Resolution authorizing the transfer of the governance, assets, liabilities and obligations of the Authority to Alberta Health Services on April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS the members of the Authority wish to provided for the orderly wind-up of the affairs of the Authority and dissolution of the Authority in a timely manner after April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS the Authority was established by a By-Law of each of the members and it is therefore necessary that each of the members pass a By-Law for the wind-up and dissolution of the Authority;

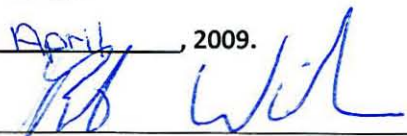
NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in it by the *Municipal Government Act* (Alberta) the Council of Parkland County enacts as follows:

1. Parkland County as a member of the Authority shall take all reasonable steps and do all things necessary to, as soon as reasonably practicable after April 1, 2009, and in a timely, orderly and cost efficient manner pursuant to the Agreement, as amended, wind up the affairs of the Authority and dissolve the Authority.
2. That this By-Law shall come into force and effect upon the date of final passage.

READ A FIRST TIME this 14 day of April, 2009.

READ A SECOND TIME this 14 day of April, 2009.

READ A THIRD TIME and passed this 14 day of April, 2009.
