

ROAD BAN

Effective Monday, March 20, 2017 at 0800 hrs

Parkland County would like to remind all road users that the road ban season is fast approaching. Typically, bans are initiated in mid-March and last through to the end of May. ALL OILED and HARD surfaced roads in Parkland County will be banned. The majority of the oil and hard surfaced roads will have a 75% restriction placed on them.

Road Bans are placed on sensitive roads to protect them during their weakest point to minimize damage. When the frost comes out of a road, it becomes very soft under its top surface and is more likely to sustain damage. Road bans can also be on to limit very large loads, keeping them off of the roads to protect short stretches, allowing only smaller vehicle access.

Below are the axle limits showing your allowable 100% weight and the maximum allowable that would be required to reduce down to.




Single and Twin Steer Truck

Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight cannot exceed the sum of the maximum allowable axle weights.




Truck and Full Trailer

Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight cannot exceed the sum of the maximum allowable axle weights up to maximum GVW of 55,300 kg.




Truck and Pony Trailer

Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight cannot exceed the sum of the maximum allowable axle weights.



Tractor Semi-Trailer

Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight cannot exceed the sum of the maximum allowable axle weights.



Fines range from \$39/100kg to \$54/100kg for more serious overloads (5000kg & up), plus the 15% Victim Fine Surcharge.
