

## **Agricultural Bursary Application**

Up to five, \$500 bursaries, are awarded to post-secondary students who are enrolled in an Agriculturerelated program.

## **Eligibility requirements**

- 1. Applicants must be a resident of Parkland County or have lived in the County within the last three years.
- 2. Must be accepted or currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution in an Agriculturerelated program or proof of acceptance into a post-secondary institution.
- 3. Applicants must provide an essay outlining their rural experience, community involvement, volunteer and recreational activities. Indicate career goals and objectives as they relate to their field of study and agriculture.
