BYLAW 2023-20

BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESCINDING BYLAW 2022-07 – WATERFRONT PARK

WHEREAS Council of Parkland County wishes to pass a bylaw for the purpose of rescinding Parkland County Bylaw 2022-07 – Waterfront Park that was enacted for the purpose of governing the use of the parking and launch areas at the Waterfront Park; and

WHEREAS pursuant to section 63 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, a council may, by bylaw, omit and provide for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective; and

WHEREAS Council enacted Bylaw 2023-16 – Parks that causes Bylaw 2022-07 – Waterfront Park to be redundant and no longer required;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Parkland County, duly assembled and under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, as amended, hereby enacts the following:

1. That upon third reading of Bylaw 2023-20, Bylaw 2022-07 and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST TIME this 12th day of December, 2023.

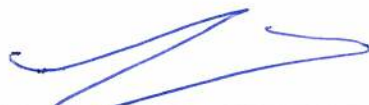
READ A SECOND TIME this 12th day of December, 2023.
