PURPOSE

Parkland County wishes to acknowledge and provide recognition to Hamlets and Community Associations celebrating a 50th, 75th, 100th, or 125th year as a community within Parkland County.

POLICY

Parkland County may contribute up to \$1,500.00 to a Hamlet or Community Association within Parkland County hosting a function or celebrating 50, 75, or 125 years, and up to \$2,500.00 for 100 years as a Hamlet or Community Association within Parkland County. Parkland County will also award a plaque to be displayed in a prominent location within the Hamlet or Community Association facility in recognition of the anniversary.

1. Matching Requirement:

Parkland County's contribution may be utilized for any function or celebration honoring the anniversaries as approved in this policy. Funding provided by the County will be on a 50%/50% matching basis with the host organization being responsible for providing an equal contribution to the function or celebration.

2. Eligibility

A Hamlet or Community Association must be within the boundary of Parkland County at the time of the anniversary to be eligible for the contribution from Parkland County. Community Associations must also meet the association recognition and grant eligibility criteria contained in County Policy RP 016.

3. Funding

Parkland County requires that a host committee be formed and that the host committee be a "Registered Non-profit society," or the host committee be formed under the direction of a "Registered Non-profit society".

Parkland County requires that a budget and event outline be presented to Council at least six (6) months prior to the event or function, and a complete accounting of the event or function be submitted to the County no later than ninety (90) days after the event or function.
