Community League Funding- Operating General Information

Parkland County annual grant to assist Community Leagues with the operation of community halls and certain outdoor recreational amenities and to assist with the provision of programs and activities to community residents. This grant is available to groups in good standing that are listed as Parkland County Community Associations in policy RP 0016.

Financial assistance available (annual maximum is contingent on Council-approved operating budget for that year):

- A. 50% of eligible hall operating costs for:
 - Utilities: Sewer/Septic, Electricity, heating, water
 - Contracted Operational Services
 - Outdoor Maintenance (ex. gas for lawn mower, plants, gravel)
 - Life safety inspections (ex. Playground inspections, fire suppression inspections)
- B. Connectivity
 - A. Internet broadband costs for monthly/annual Broadband charges.*
 - * Not available for 2025 as it was paid through the 2024 Data grant
 - B. **Software Licenses and Subscriptions** (Funding for purchasing licenses for essential software tools and Cloud-based operating systems such as accounting software, project management tools, and other specialized applications for conducting Community League Business)
 - C. **Technology Training** (Funding to enhance the skills of volunteers to ensure they are up to date on the technology needed to operate more efficiently and effectively.)
 - D. **Website Hosting, Development, and Maintenance** (Funding to host, build, or redesign, a nonprofit's website, ensuring it is user-friendly, accessible, and up-to-date with current technologies)
- C. **Outdoor amenities funding** for annual operation, maintenance, and/or repairs and upgrades to any of the following existing community-based outdoor recreational amenities: outdoor rink, soccer pitch, ball diamonds, horse ring, and playground. (amounts listed in the application)

Community Leagues applying for Outdoor Amenity Funding are responsible for ensuring that the outdoor amenity is in good operating condition. Parks, Recreation, and Culture staff, or designate, may conduct periodic site inspections to ensure proper operation, maintenance, and community use of the funded amenity. The County retains the right to deny funding if proper operations and maintenance are not carried out or if community use is not evident.

Community Leagues that receive operational funding from other levels of government or are affiliated with groups that receive this funding are not eligible to apply for the Community League Operating Grant.

To complete this grant, fill in the highlighted boxes in the document and attach *all* required documentation outlined in the Required Attachments section of this application.

Application deadline is May 1, 2025
