

BYLAW NO. 37-2008

PARKLAND COUNTY

A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND LEASING OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of Parkland County deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter leasing of same, and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Section 22(4) of the Municipal Government Act requires the Council of a municipality to provide opportunity for public input and for any persons who claim to be affected prejudicially by this bylaw, to be heard by Council,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of PARKLAND COUNTY in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of leasing of the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

All that portion of the Statutory Road allowance lying West of the North West Quarter of Section 32 Township 54 Range 06 West of the 5th Meridian commencing at the North West limit of the said Quarter Section thence Southerly 255.0 meters, containing approximately 0.512 hectares (1.26 acres) of land

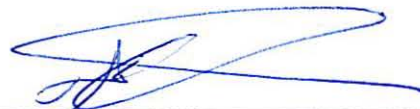
