BYLAW 2024-04

BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 2023-15 - USE OF COUNTY LAND

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, and amendments thereto, council has the authority to pass and amend bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and

WHEREAS section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 200 c M-26, provides that council of a municipality may pass a bylaw to amend a bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Parkland County, duly assembled and under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, as amended, hereby enacts the following:

TITLE

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Use of County Land Amending Bylaw".

INTERPRETATION

2. The headings in this bylaw are for reference purposes only.

BYLAW 2023-15 AMENDMENTS

3. That Bylaw 2023-15 being the Use of County Land Bylaw is amended as follows:

DEFINITIONS

Replace the definition of "Unauthorized Use" as defined in Section 2(20), with the following:

(20) "Unauthorized Use" means a use that is prohibited pursuant to section 7 of this Bylaw, or a use for which a permit is required, but has not been granted, pursuant to section 8 of this Bylaw;

ENACTMENT/TRANSITION

4. Should any provision of this Bylaw be deemed invalid then such invalid provision will be severed from this Bylaw and such severance will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw, except to the extent necessary to give effect to such severance.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of third reading and signing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME this 23rd day of January, 2024.

READ A SECOND TIME this 23rd day of January, 2024.

READ A THIRD TIME and finally passed this 23rd day of January, 2024.
