

BY-LAW NO. 31-2006

PARKLAND COUNTY

A BY-LAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL A PORTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of Parkland County deems it expedient to provide for a by-law for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality.

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by this By-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of PARKLAND COUNTY in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

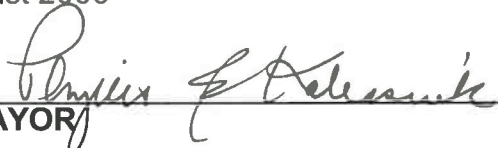
Portion of Sunset Avenue:

All that portion of Sunset Avenue

Lying south of a line drawn perpendicular to the East boundary of Lot 12, Block 4 through a point on the said East boundary 36.5 meters south of the intersection of the said East boundary with the South West limit of Plan 3384CL.

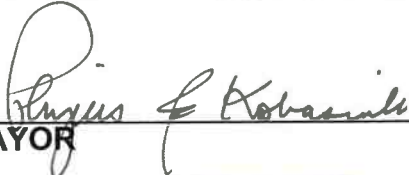
