PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to meet the requirements of the Peace Officer Act to establish for Parkland County Peace Officers.

POLICY STATEMENT

Parkland County shall abide by the Alberta Peace Officer Act and Regulations, and commit to follow the Public Security Peace Officer Program Policy and Procedure Manual, and any amendments thereto.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. "Peace Officer" shall have the same meaning as "Peace Officer" described in the Provincial Offences Procedures Act, which includes County Community Peace Officers and Bylaw Enforcement Officers.
- 2. "Public Security Peace Officer Program" is the provincial government program which gives authority to other levels of government to employ peace officers for community safety and/or specialized enforcement purposes.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all Peace Officers and Bylaw Enforcement Officers employed by Parkland County.

MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The Manager of Community and Protective Services is responsible for the implementing, monitoring and evaluation of this policy, along with developing and recommending operational procedures. Supervisors are responsible for the day-to-day implementation in the field.

STANDARDS

Parkland County may develop procedures to meet local needs, being in line with the spirit and intent
of the applicable provincial legislation and the guidelines set by the Solicitor General and Public
Security.
